Key Features

- Roll-up individual grant budgets for overall program or bureau planning.
- Track budgets to obligated costs and payments.
- Complete process for approving plan and package.

- Notifications/alerts for upcoming tasks, milestones, status changes, missed due dates, completed actions and more.
- Report on milestones and metrics.
